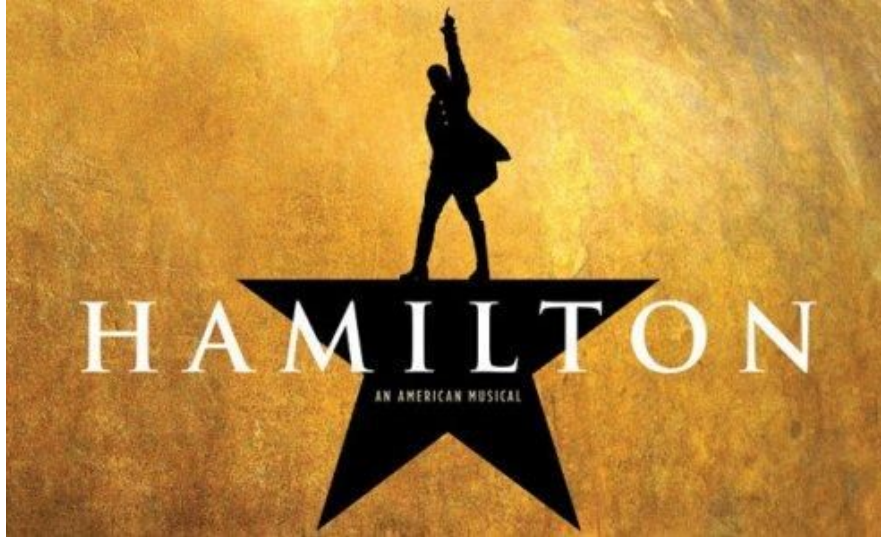


CLAY THEATRE STUDENTS ARE GOING TO SEE
