WHAT IS EXPECTED FROM MAGNET STUDENTS, TEACHERS, AND PARENTS?


The *Visual & Performing Arts Magnet* staff believes that students achieve their maximum potential through the *collaborative* efforts of students, their parents and their teachers.

STUDENT RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Attend school every day and be in class on time.
- Come to class prepared by having the needed materials and assigned work.
- Complete assigned work by the date it is due.
- Attend fine arts and magnet events as required.
- Follow rules and expectations for academics, behavior, and attendance.



If you are absent from a class, it is **YOUR** responsibility to ask for the missed work and complete the assignments within the timeframe required by the teacher.



TEACHER RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Maintain a productive, positive learning environment.
- Use varied and motivational classroom techniques to achieve the curriculum goals.
- Grade all assignments and exams in a timely manner.
- Review and discuss assignments and exams with the class after grading to increase student learning.
 - Contact parents when students are not performing in accordance with expectations.
- Respond to contacts from parents in a timely manner.

PARENT/GUARDIAN RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Demonstrate interest in your child's work and work habits.
- Provide your child with a time and place to do homework that is free from distractions.
- Attend parent information meetings and parent/ teacher conferences to stay informed and monitor your child's progress.
- Contact magnet staff regarding your child's progress In the magnet program.
- Become involved in school & magnet activities whenever possible – i.e. attend performances, chaperone field trips, volunteer to help with special activities, etc.
- Provide transportation for your child to attend required events and rehearsals outside the regular school day.
